Challenge 500 (2016) Terms and Conditions

In these terms and conditions “YE”, “We”, “Us” or “Our” means HERIB (registered charity number 223668) and “You”, “Your”, or the “Organisation” means the business that participates in Challenge 500 2015 (also referred to as the “Challenge”). “Participant” means any individual who partakes in the Challenge.

Entry to the Challenge must be through the official application form process only. Complete and sign the registration form and return it to the Challenge 500 Coordinator via email: angelag@herib.co.uk or post to: Challenge 500, HERIB, Beech Holme, Beverley Road, Hull, HU5 1NF

The Challenge is open to all businesses within Hull and East Yorkshire but HERIB employees and their families are not permitted to enter.

1. The Challenge

1.1 We will pledge to You £50 (fifty pounds sterling) per business (the total funds advanced are referred to as “the Funds” in these terms and conditions).

1.2 Participants may work as a groups (a “Team”) or individually.

1.3 Participants are challenged to make as much profit as possible and engage with their local community through enterprising activities between 1st February and 31st October 2016 (inclusive). All enterprising activities must be specifically created for the Challenge.

1.4 Any business which involves gambling, fraud or illegal activities is not permitted.

1.5 We may disqualify You and/or the Participants from the Challenge if We have reasonable grounds to suspect that You and/or the Participant(s) are in breach of these terms and conditions or Your or a Participant’s participation in the Challenge involved gambling, was fraudulent, or otherwise unlawful.

1.6 You shall only use the Funds for the purpose of the Challenge. You will return any Funds that are not used for the purposes of the Challenge within 31 days of receipt.

1.7 You shall be responsible for distribution of the Funds to the Participants and all supervision of the activities of the Participants in relation to the Challenge. You shall not distribute any Funds prior to 1st February 2016.

1.8 You must pledge to return the original £50 on completion of the Challenge, even in the event that You do not make a profit

1.9 You shall pay all monies received from all Participants to Us by the closing date of the challenge which is 31st March 2016 by electronic payment. Our bank details will be provided when the Funds are initially advanced to You. Payment by cheque is also accepted in the event that You are unable to make an electronic payment. Cheques should be made payable to “HERIB”.

2. Prize and winner announcement

2.1 You will receive a certificate of achievement. We will inform You if you receive any other prize award by the 30th November 2016. No cash alternative will be offered and the prize is non-transferable and non-exchangeable. The prize is subject to change at Our discretion.

3. Publicity

3.1 You accept that, by participating in the Challenge or if one of You win an award, We will have the right, without additional permission, to use the name, address and other details of your Organisation for related promotional purposes.

4. Data privacy

4.1 On registration You will need to provide details including the name and postcode of your Organisation and the name, telephone number and email address of the person supervising the Participants at the Organisation.

4.2 The information you supply to us may be used in a number of ways, including:

- 4.2.1 to process your registration to participate in the Challenge;
- 4.2.2 to verify your identity;
- 4.2.3 to support your participation in the Challenge;
- 4.2.4 for promoting the Challenge;
- 4.2.5 for collection of the funds provided to you;
- 4.2.6 to identify other schemes which might be of interest to you (with your consent); and
- 4.2.7 to prevent fraud and money laundering.

4.4 We will not pass your contact details to third parties for marketing purposes, but we may from time to time send communications to you about future HERIB events that we believe may be of interest to you. 5.1 To the fullest extent permitted by law, We shall not be liable to You for any costs, expenses, loss or damage (whether direct, indirect or consequential, and whether economic or other) arising from entry in the Challenge, or any prize or award, or any damage to any Participant or computer or any other equipment used to upload or download material relating to this Challenge.

5.2 Participants will not benefit from Our public liability insurance.

5.3 You shall be responsible for the health and safety of all Participants and compliance with all relevant legal requirements.

5.4 We may cancel or suspend the Challenge for any reason beyond Our reasonable control with immediate effect by notice in writing (including email). We may amend these rules without notice, by posting changes to them on the website www.herib.co.uk.
